

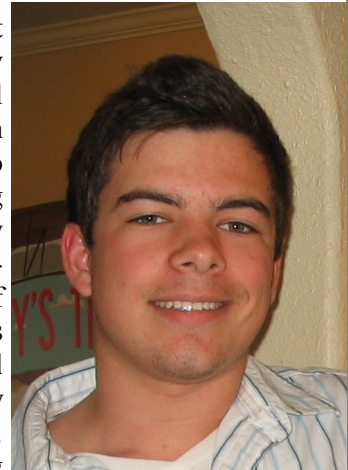
# CHICO SUMMER FLIGHT ACADEMY ALUMNI CLASS OF 2009
